Dear Parents/Carers,

As I am sure most of you are aware, our staff car park is not very big. There are not enough parking bays for all of the staff who travel to school in a car, therefore we have to use down the middle of the car park as extra parking.

For Health and Safety reasons we are no longer able to park 2 rows of cars down the middle. We have to leave room for emergency vehicles (ambulances and fire engines) to be able to access the yard. This was highlighted a while ago when we had an injured child on the yard and needed to get an ambulance to her, but were unable to because of parked cars. Luckily on this occasion it wasn't a serious injury.

With this in mind we are no longer able to let parents use the car park. If you are visiting school for any reason, you will have to park in the multi-storey on Mount Pleasant, or at the pay and display on Mount Pleasant or Brownlow Hill. We will, however, still open the gates onto the yard for any after school activities arranged by school, such as parent's evenings.

I am sorry for any inconvenience this may cause, but I am sure you will agree with me that the safety of the children has to be our priority.
