Dear Parents/Carers,

We have started to receive letters to inform us that children are being taken to their home countries or on holiday during term time.

As I have explained in the past, I cannot authorise any holiday during term time. If you do take your child/children on holiday then you may face a fine of £60.00 per parent per child for the absence.

If you take your child out of school to return to your home country for any length of time, again we cannot hold open your place in school. Many of our classes have the maximum amount of pupils in them, and if you leave school we may offer your place to someone who is on the waiting list. This means that upon your return you may have to find a different school for your child.
