We will continue to explore our numbers of the week but our main focus this half term will be doubles, halving, size and measures.

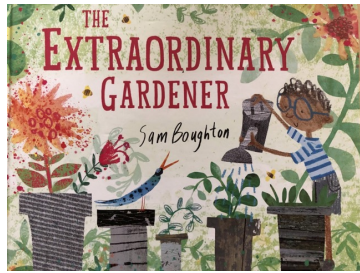

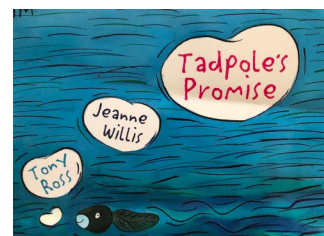
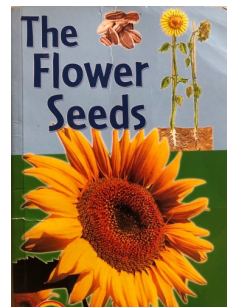
