Artist Study, 3D Art	Down Our Street: This unit will build on the work in Y1, the children will study local buildings and a focus on an architect that designed a significant building. Year 4	Henry Rousseau and Beatriz- Mihazes: Focus artists, Rousseau and Mihazes, research, compare and contrast and create a piece of work in a similar style. Painting, Artist/Architecture Study, Digital Art?	Islamic Art: Focus on pattern and repetition. Printing, Artist/Architecture Study, Digital Art? Children complete Grafitti workshop at Zap. Create their own 'street art' design. Artist/3D Art/Digital Art/Painting
