

Pleasant Street Reception Knowledge Organiser Summer



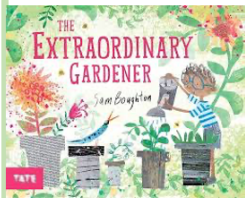
The focus term will be...

In summer half term 1 the focus will be on lifecycles of plants and animals and growth. Reception will also be focusing on what places are special, caring respectful relationships and observational pictures. In PE Reception will develop overhead throwing, striking and jumping.

In summer half term 2 the focus will be on traditional tales, what is special in our world, collaging and transitions into year 1. In PE Reception will focus on running, jumping, shapes and team-work preparing for our sports day event.

Mathematics: This term Reception will focus on extending counting skills of larger numbers, compare quantities and number, continue to develop one more and one less and continue to develop subitising skills.

Little Red: journey, forest, growled, plan, shortcut, spare, nightdress, peeped and leapt.

Extraordinary Gardener:

- What kind of plant will the seed grow into?
- What is the name of the object that holds the water?
- Where should you put the plant pot to get sunlight?
- Why do you need to label plant pot?
- When should you water the seed?

Little Red:

- Do they know the story?
- Which characters are in the story?
- Which are the good characters?
- Which are the bad characters?
- Where does Little Red Riding Hood live?
- How does she feel about going to Grandma's house? How do you know?
- Do you think Little Red Riding Hood has been to Grandma's house before?
