Attendance

Our school attendance for this academic year is currently 96.2% which is close to our target of 97%. We continue to track attendance and punctuality robustly as research states that this is the most important factor in enhancing children's life chances. We continue to work with the Education Welfare Office to support families who struggle with attendance and punctuality.
