**Homework:** Homework: Children will usually be given an English and Maths activity per week, the homework will be related to topics they have covered recently. It is intended to consolidate learning which has taken place within the classroom. Homework will usually be issued through SeeSaw, so regular checking will ensure your child excels. For further support on what is expected, please visit the 'Parents' section of our school website.

**Reading:** Every pupil will read 1:1 with Miss Halli every week. Those children requiring more support will read on more than one occasion per week. Please read at home with your child regularly and ensure their book is up to date and brought in every day.

**Basic Skills:** The children complete a basic skills 4 a day session every morning (8.55-9:05) which covers the four operations of number. It is important that your child arrives on time each morning to take part in these sessions.

**English:** The first half term we are reading When we walked on the moon. From this text children will write an exploration narrative. In the second half of the term children will read The Lost Book of Adventure.

**Maths:** We will be covering the following topics in Maths: Shape, Position and Direction, Decimals, Negative numbers, Converting units and Volume. The 4 operations will be covered in basic skills sessions.

**Science:** Topics this term are Animals including Humans and Living Things and their Habitats.

**Computing**: The units of learning are: The Internet and World Wide Web and 3D Modelling.

**History:** Our topic this half term is the Ancient Greeks. Please help your children to learn the key vocabulary words attached.

**Geography:** Our topic this half term is Rivers and Fieldwork.

**RE:** We will be answering the enquiry question: 'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?'

PSHE: We are looking at 'Image sharing' and 'Growing and Changing: Puberty.'

**Music:** The children will be singing with Mrs. Grindley and learning about different musical genres. The topic is Tempo and Composition; Music arrangements

**Spanish:** The children will continue to learn Spanish phrases and vocabulary with Mrs. Grindley. The topics are family members, musical instruments and hobbies; countries, flags and nationalities.

**Art:** In the second half of the term the topic is Mixed Media.

**DT:** The topic is Pulleys and Gears. The children will be supported by the UK Military school.
