We will be rescreening your child in 12 weeks.

- Relating two and three objects together
- Pointing to their eyes/nose/mouth
- Carrying out actions on toys
- Following 2-word instructions
- Following instructions out of the routine
- Occasionally putting two words together when talking
- Giving you an item on request
- Point to the correct picture when asked
- Using everyday objects on himself
- Pretending to use objects on himself
- Following everyday instructions
- Starting a routine or game with an adult
- Point to things of interest
- Using words to request things
- Using gestures to request things
- Using his/her name
- Joining in with songs and rhymes
- Starting to tell you about things that they have seen
